## Teaching Guide

The Cincinnati Enquirer article only covered the first two days of the Garner Case. An abbreviated set of notes, called *The Rest of the Garner Story*, can be printed for each student to use in formulating a story about how the case ended. An article that deals with the historical facts in more detail is also available, called *The Garner Fugitive Slave Case*, although the reading is pretty high level. You may choose to read sections from this document to supplement the student sheet. It is very comprehensive and worth reading.

Having already discussed the art and intention of Persuasive Writing, students can be instructed to take a view point and attempt to influence their readers however they chose. Alternatively, several viewpoints that you select can be given to them to select from.
